

# Getting to Yokohama

## Access from Overseas

Getting to Yokohama from anywhere in the world is easy, thanks to the city's proximity to two international airports, Tokyo International Airport (Haneda) and Narita International Airport. The two airports together handle more than 2,100 international flights weekly from more than 90 cities in some 36 nations on more than 70 airlines. Proximity and extensive air service make Yokohama an especially effective venue for attracting convention participants from nations of Asia, Europe, and North America.

- More than 1,500 flights weekly from 40 countries
- Direct flights from over 90 cities around the world



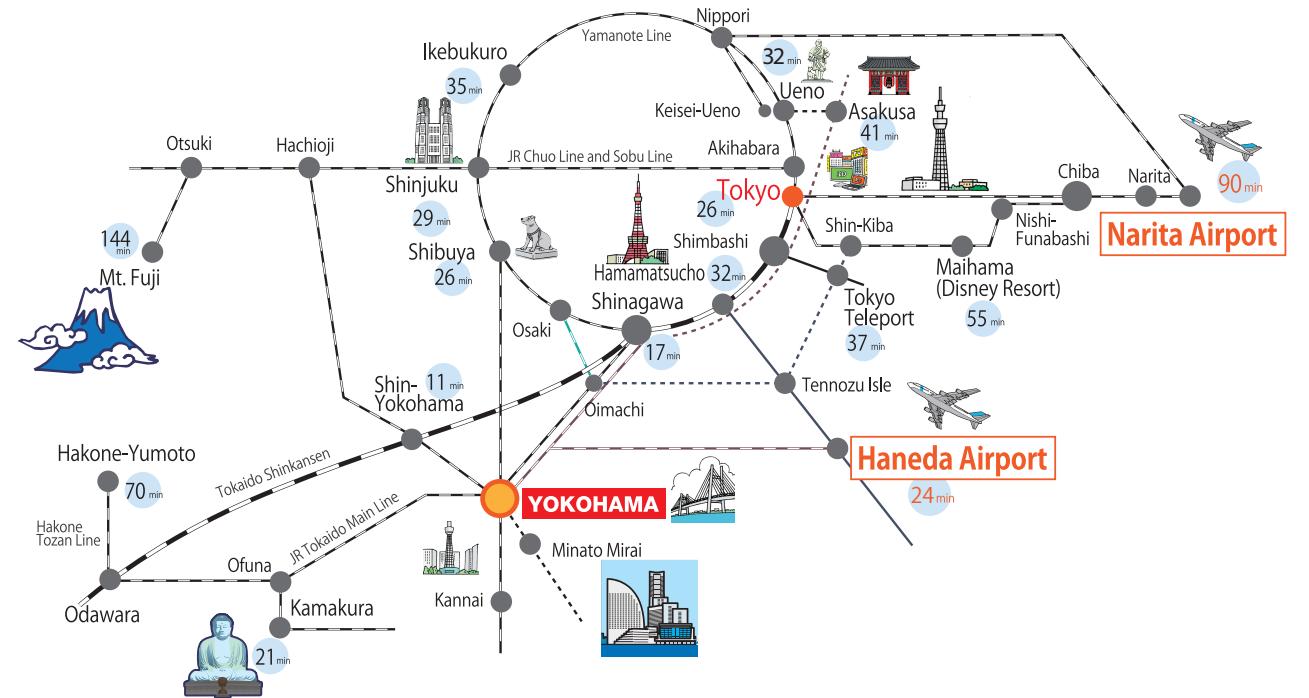

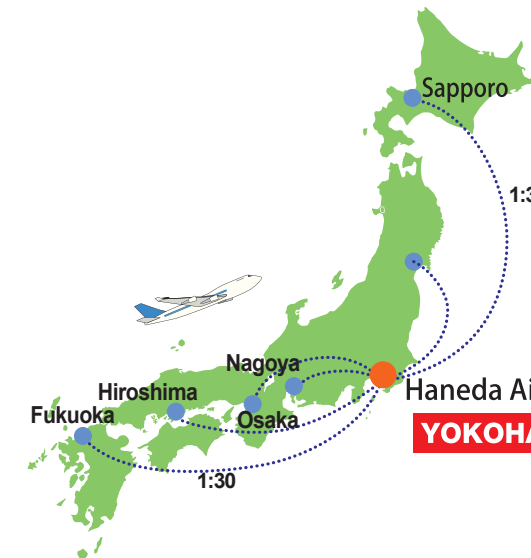

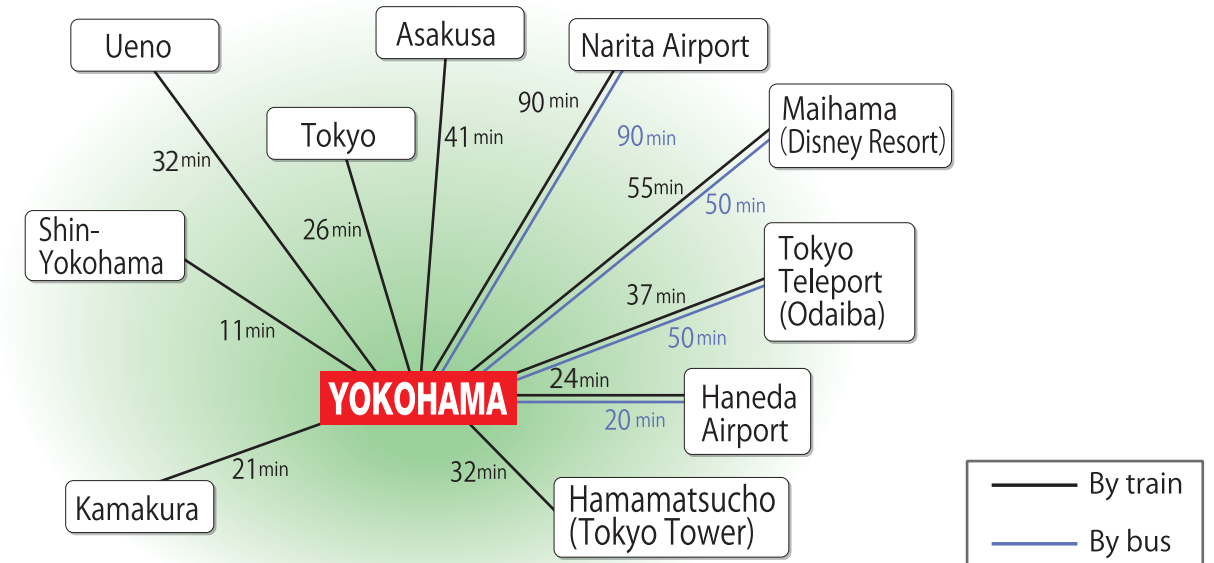
